## Shoe Box Ideas

### Toys

Small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoos, Harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, small Etch A Sketch, toys that light up or make noise (with extra batteries) Slinky, etc.

### School Supplies

### Other

Hard candy and lollipops (please double bag all candy) mints, t-shirts, socks, ball caps; sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries).

### A Personal Note

### DO NOT INCLUDE:

Toothpaste, chewing gum, used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives or military figures; chocolate or food; liquids or lotions; medication or vitamins; breakable items such as snow-globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.
