He came looking for the "American Dream" - security and success, but his search took a whole different turn when his wife, Shulamit, became a believer in Yeshua (Jesus). Boris resisted her witness and argued vehemently with her. But as he began to read the Bible for himself, he sensed the reality of God. After a year and a half of searching, he accepted Yeshua as his Savior.

Boris helped begin a few new Russian outreaches in Brooklyn, New York.
