### FROM YOUR PASTOR

I trust you are having a great week. Isn't it encouraging to know that God is always good, and He is always in control? There is never panic in Heaven, only plans. I know we all face difficult days from time to time, but God always provides grace and strength to aid us in going through all of our days. God is faithful and true.

The Lord willing, I plan to speak this Sunday morning about Barnabas the Encourager, and how he is such a wonderful example to us as to what a Christian is to be by God's grace. This past Sunday, I preached about Zacchaeus from Luke 19:1-10 in a message entitled, "Jesus Knows Your Name". And the Sunday prior, I preached about Apollos from Acts 18:24-28, in a message entitled, "Apollos, the Passionate Believer".

I plan to preach about other people in the Bible over the next few months, people you need to know. God gives us these men and women in His Holy Word as examples of encouragement, instruction, and of warning. You need to know about them. These are messages God wants you to hear, and I believe they will be helpful to you in many ways. I hope to see you every Sunday morning for this special series of messages.

Please remember we have worship services at **Trinity Village every fourth Sunday at 4 p. m.** We have members who are residents at Trinity Village who attend these services, who I know would be thrilled to see you at these services as you are able. It is always a wonderful time of singing, worship, and fellowship. You are invited and encouraged to attend.

On Thursday evening, March 2, at 6:30 p. m., First Baptist will provide pizzas, salads, soft drinks and desserts to the Baptist Collegiate Ministry (BCM) at UAPB. We are also invited to join them in Bible study at that time, and to share the meal with them. Matthew Hall is the new Director of the BCM ministry at both UAPB and at SEARK, and we welcome him and his wife, Rebekah, to our area, and we look forward to being active partners with them as they minister here. Matthew will be speaking at FBC soon.

Saturday night, March 11, please move your clocks forward one hour as Daylight Saving Time begins. On Thursday, March 16, at 3:30 p. m. FBC will provide a meal for the teachers and staff of Coleman Elementary school from Lybrands. Please let me know if you can help with this.

On Sunday evening at 5 p. m., March 12, Ann and I will show pictures of the Holy Land as it was in the first century, as it is today, and of our recent trip there. We will have a fellowship meal together also at 5 p. m.

Beginning March 12 and going through May 21 (except Easter and Mother's Day), at 5 p. m., we will have a church fellowship and will view Season 3 of the "The Chosen" video series.

"The Chosen" is truly a unique video series on Jesus' calling His followers during His earthly ministry. The background information of that day and the lives of Jesus' followers are so very well presented. This series will really help you see Jesus through the eyes of those who knew Him and followed Him. Again, I believe it will be helpful to be present for the viewing of pictures of the Holy Land on March 12 to help give a better understanding of the setting of "The Chosen".

First Baptist Church will host about 20-25 volunteer workers from the Harmony Baptist Association in Missouri on March 25-April 1, as they will come to Pine Bluff to work on various ministry projects in our city. They will be staying in our church facilities, and we will need some volunteers to assist them during their stay. Please get with me if you can help.

We have a church prayer meeting every Wednesday at noon and you are encouraged to attend. Palm Sunday is April 2, Good Friday service is April 7 at 6 p. m. The Lord's Supper will be a part of the Good Friday service, as well as the Sanctuary Choir presenting "Candles of Grace—A Service of Tenebrae". Easter Sunday is April 9.

World Changers plans to return to Pine Bluff the week of July 24-29. Please place this week on your calendars, as we will probably be hosting 75-100 people who will work and minister in Pine Bluff and stay at our church during that week. The city of Pine Bluff has already graciously agreed to support this effort by providing worksites, materials and supplies.


