FROM YOUR PASTOR

Throughout the United States this Tuesday, July 4, most everyone will be celebrating the anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence -- a document through which leaders of the colonies in the New World broke free from the autocratic rule of the King of England.

The declaration begins, "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." Do not take this sentence lightly, and do not let others encourage you to forget it.

Revisionist historians are working hard to remove any trace of Christian and Biblical ideals from the foundations of America. But our Fourth of July celebration finds its basis in this foundational document which appeals to the authority of a Divine Creator, One Whom most our founding fathers fully believed to have been the author and main subject of the Holy Bible, and who was the guarantor of certain "inalienable rights". So, the Fourth of July – more than just a celebration of independence, ought also to be a day which recognizes God's participation in our nation's birth.

I have read and heard all kinds of advice about how America ought to be transformed. Most Americans believe elections and the orderly, lawful democratic process is how political change should happen. But there are now those who seek to change our nation through chaos, destruction and anarchy.

God's covenant offer to a nation is being ignored right now. The words found in 2 Chronicles 7:14 could be claimed and applied to any nation, but particularly one whose foundational documents and institutions have drawn their inspiration substantially from Biblical monotheism. "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."

If we truly want to see healing brought to our nation, then this conditional covenant is for us and the restoration of our land will require our part in the covenant: humility, prayer and repentance, so that God can forgive our sin and heal our land!

True restoration and healing for an individual, a church and a nation only comes through true repentance and God's grace! With so much work to be done -- may restoration begin with us!

World Changers is coming to Pine Bluff 24-28 July, and First Baptist will have a huge role in their presence and ministry in our community. We will be hosting around 60-70 that week, providing a place for them to stay in our facilities, as well as shower units. They will have their own cooks to provide their own breakfast and dinner meals in our kitchen and fellowship hall. Several areas churches will be helping us this week, especially in providing lunches for these folks as they serve in our community.

We anticipate feeding two worksites that week. We are also anticipating local businesses to donate lunches, and then we will need to ask our Sunday School classes to prepare at least one lunch for workers that week. I will speak to our Sunday School classes directly about the lunch needs for this week.

- 1) World Changers will arrive on Monday, 24 June. I anticipate most to arrive around 1-4 p. m.. We need members to be on hand to greet our guests.
- 2) We need at least 2 men and 2 ladies Monday through Friday evenings from 5-9 p. m. to be on hand to assist with needs of our guests.
- 3) We will have homemade ice cream on one evening around 7 p. m., so please bring your ice cream freezers. We will tentatively plan to do this on Tuesday evening.
 - 4) We will have cold watermelons on Thursday evening for our guests.
- 5) World Changers will have a worship service in our fellowship hall on Wednesday evening, time to be announced. Our church is encouraged to attend this service. Thank you for your help with World Changers

The Organ Repairs Have Begun. The organ repairs began on Wednesday, June 28, and are being caringly done by R. A. Colby Organs of Johnson City, Tennessee. The work crew will take down each division chamber independently and seal off the winding system to the section they are working on so that everything else will be usable for Sunday morning worship.

Janine has proven to be an innovative person, so I am sure she will work miracles during this process.

It will take the crew a few months to do the renovation work, and they anticipate having the organ back and fully playing sometime in October. They will then tune the pipes and have the full organ playable for the Advent season. In January 2024, they will come back and pull the console (the unit of keyboards that Janine plays from) and take it to their home office in Tennessee. There, they will work on the electrical components and the additional organ sounds so that the entire organ is back and upgraded before Easter 2024!

Please be in prayer for Nick Ollis, the foreman of the Colby Organ department and our project leader, and his crew as they travel back and forth to Pine Bluff, climb the ladders, and do their work safely.
