Grace and peace to you from our Lord Jesus Christ!

Tori and I recently had the opportunity to attend a conference called the "Speaking the Truth in Love Conference" at Founders Baptist Church in Spring, TX. This is the third year we have attended this conference, and each time we have gone, it has been incredibly edifying and refreshing for us, as we have sat under solid preaching of God's Word and enjoyed rich fellowship with some of our Christian friends who also attend. I would like to thank Dr. Mike Manning of the Harmony Baptist Association for preaching in my stead while I was away, and I would also like to express thanks to you, church member, for graciously allowing us to go to this conference.

For this month's builder article, I would like to share the main takeaways from that conference. I would encourage you, if you have some spare time, to go and listen to the sermons from the conference, which are available for free on the Founders Baptist Church Youtube channel or at <u>truthinlove.org</u>. The theme this year was "Conviction: Truth Worth Dying For." We were reminded of those in Scripture and in church history who died for the gospel of Jesus Christ. The whole conference served as a challenge to be convictional in our biblical beliefs, to the point where we are willing to face persecution of various kinds, even death if it comes to that.

Revelation 13:10 states very bluntly- "If anyone is to be taken captive, to captivity he goes; if anyone is to be slain with the sword, with the sword he must be slain." In other words, if God in His providence has ordained that you would face imprisonment or death for the gospel of Jesus Christ, so be it. We must adopt that mindset. This can be a difficult attitude to subscribe ourselves to in our culture and nation, where we have not in large part had to face strong persecution for our faith. But we do not know what the future holds, and we must be prepared, with conviction, to die for the truth. The verse ends with this- "Here is a call for the endurance and faith of the saints." Let us endure with faith whatever God has in store for us.

A closing thought that is relevant to each of us- if we are going to be men and women of conviction around the truth, which is what the modern church, our nation, and the world desperately need, we must know what the truth is. That means we must give ourselves to the knowledge of God through His Word. I would encourage each of you to do this-read Scripture, meditate on Scripture, memorize Scripture, and as you do, pray that the Spirit would form strong conviction in your heart, to the degree that you would not flinch in the face of death because you are standing firm on the truth of God's Word.


