Grace and peace to you from our Lord Jesus Christ!

One of my favorite parts of the week is our Wednesday prayer meeting that we hold at noon. I know several of you are very faithful to join us at that meeting, and I want to express my appreciation for that. I know many of you are unable to regularly attend, and that is okay! I trust you are faithful to pray for our church members and their various physical and spiritual needs whether you attend the meeting or not.

For those that have not been able to join us, one thing that you have been missing out on is our current devotional study before we turn to the Lord in prayer. We have been going through the Attributes of God during that time, where we focus on one of the characteristics of God each meeting and we take the time to look at various parts of Scripture that teach us about that characteristic. The reason for this study during the prayer meeting is simple- we should know as much as we can about the God that we are praying to!

Theologians tend to place the Attributes of God into two major categories- God's Incommunicable Attributes and God's Communicable Attributes. Simply speaking, God's Incommunicable Attributes are those aspects of his nature and character that are unique to him and not shared with us, while God's Communicable Attributes are those aspects of his nature and character that he does share with us, and that we can emulate (although certainly to a much lesser degree).

For example, attributes such as God's omniscience (his knowledge of everything), God's independence (the fact that he does not rely on anyone or anything outside of himself for his existence), and God's eternality (the fact that he has no beginning or end) are *incommunicable attributes.* They are not shared with us, because we will never know everything, we will always depend on God for our existence, and we have a beginning.

On the other hand, attributes such as God's wisdom, God's righteousness, and God's love are *communicable attributes*. They are shared with us, as we were created with the capacity to exhibit them in our own lives. This capacity has of course been tarnished and twisted by sin, so that we do not and cannot possess true godly wisdom, practice true righteousness, or demonstrate biblical love until we are redeemed in Christ and given a new heart. But the fact remains, God created us with the capacity to share in those attributes, and that capacity is realized when trust in Jesus Christ.

I share all of this to say- we should learn both the Incommunicable and Communicable Attributes and meditate on them. As we focus on those ways in which God is not like us, we can declare, "Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways!" (Romans 11:33) And as we focus on those ways in which God has created us to be like him, we can strive in the power of Christ to be imitators of God, as beloved children. (Ephesians 5:1).
