TRANSITION/GROUP TIME

BIBLE STORY STATEMENTS

- » Philip walked down the road. He saw a man riding in a chariot (cart).
- » The man was reading Scriptures (Bible) from a scroll.
- » Philip helped the man know what he was reading.
- » Philip told the man about Jesus.
- » The man was happy Philip told him the Scripture words were about Jesus.

authorized adults.



BIBLE-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

PLAY WITH DOLLS

Gather: Bible, small dolls

- » Dance a doll slowly to attract a baby's attention.
- » Walk the doll on the floor.
- » Tell the Bible story statements.
- » Rest the doll beside the open Bible.
- » Encourage a child to touch the Bible.
- » Comment: "The Bible tells about Jesus. Philip helped the man learn what the Scriptures say about Jesus. We learn about Jesus from the Scriptures in our Bibles."

LOOK AT SCROLLS

Gather: Bible, cardboard paper towel or mailing tubes, assorted textured items (brown paper bag, felt, sandpaper, bubble wrap), tape
Do: Tape the cardboard tubes to each side of the textured materials and roll the tubes to the middle to make scrolls.

- » Sit on the floor with the babies and unroll one of the scrolls.
- » Encourage the babies to unroll the other scrolls.
- » Say the Bible story statements.
- » Comment that Philip read the Scriptures on the scroll and told the man what the words meant.
- » Say: "The Scriptures on the scroll are the same Scriptures in our Bibles. People use the Bible to tell others about Jesus."

LOOK OUT A WINDOW

Gather: Bible

- » Hold a baby in your arms.
- » Walk to the window.
- » Mention: "Philip walked down a road. He met a man who was reading Scriptures on a scroll. Philip helped the man know the Scriptures told about Jesus."
- » Point out objects that you can see from the window.
- » Thank God for eyes to see people, trees, and the sky.
- » Hold the Bible close for baby to touch.
- » Pray: "Thank You, God, for my eyes to see the Bible and read Your words."

PUSH CARS

Gather: Bible, small cars

- » Sit on the floor near the children.
- » Open the Bible and place it nearby.
- » Push a car toward a baby.
- » Open the Bible and tell the Bible story statements.
- » Move the car back and forth near a baby.
- » Remark: "You rode in a car to come to church today. Philip met a man riding in a chariot (cart). Philip used the Scriptures to tell him about Jesus. We read the Scriptures in our Bibles to learn about Jesus. People use the Bible to tell others about Jesus."
