### BIBLE STORY

- » Jesus walked down a road.
- » He saw ten sick men who called loudly to Him.
- » Jesus wanted to help the men.
- » He told the men to go see the priest (church helper). Jesus made the men well as they went.
- » One man returned and said, "Thank You, Jesus!"

Jesus, men, thank

### PLAY WITH A DOCTOR KIT

**Gather:** Pack Items 4, 9: "Teaching Pictures 5 & 6," "Bible Verses"; Bible, toy doctor kit, bandages, gauze, baby dolls, blanket

**Do:** Separate today's Bible Verse and place in the Bible.

- Invite the babies to play with the doctor kit items, pretending to take care of baby dolls.
- Open the Bible and say the Bible Verse.
- Remark that Jesus made the ten men feel better.
- Show Teaching Picture 6.
- Recall that one man in the Bible story said thank you to Jesus.
- Emphasize that Jesus was glad the man said thank you.

### TOUCH AND FEEL

**Gather:** Pack Item 12: "Bible Words 5 & 6"; Printables: "Allergy Alert"; scissors, gauze, bandages, plastic tub

**Do:** Separate Bible Words 6. Cut the gauze into long pieces. Place the Bible Words, gauze, and bandages in the tub. Post the Allergy Alert for the bandages.

- Encourage a baby to reach into the tub to touch the medical items.
- Explain that these items help when we are sick or hurt.
- Let a baby take a Bible Word out of the tub. Say the word. Relate it to the Bible story. Continue talking about each of the Bible Words.
- Allow another baby to feel the items in the tub. Talk about how they feel: "The cotton is soft, gauze is rough, and the bandages are sticky."
- Identify what each item is used for.
- Mention the Bible story as babies touch and feel the medical items.

### PUSH VEHICLES

**Gather:** Pack Item 4: "Teaching Pictures 5 & 6"; Bible, scissors, emergency vehicles

**Do:** Cut apart the teaching pictures. Place Teaching Picture 6 in the Bible.

- Invite a baby to play with a vehicle.
- Talk about what the vehicle does to help people who are hurt.
- Guide a baby to push a vehicle.
- Show Teaching Picture 6. Say that Jesus helped sick people feel better.
- Hold a vehicle for an infant to see.
- Mention that Jesus went from place to place to help sick people and make them well.
- Say that one of the sick men said thank you to Jesus.

### BUILD WITH BLOCKS

**Gather:** Pack Item 19: "My Community Helpers"; Bible, blocks, scissors, toy community helper figures, tape

**Do:** Cut apart the city scene and community helpers. Cut out each helper and tape to separate blocks.

- Guide a baby to play with a helper.
- Talk about what that community helper figure does to help people.
- Remark that Jesus helped ten sick men to become well.
- Sing "Jesus Went About Doing Good." (Item 26)
- Invite the babies to build with blocks.
- Say the Bible Verse: "Jesus traveled to towns and healed the sick. Matthew 9:35. One of the sick men said thank you to Jesus. We can say thank you to Jesus, too."
- Continue to play with the children.
- State: "Jesus healed people because He is God's Son."
