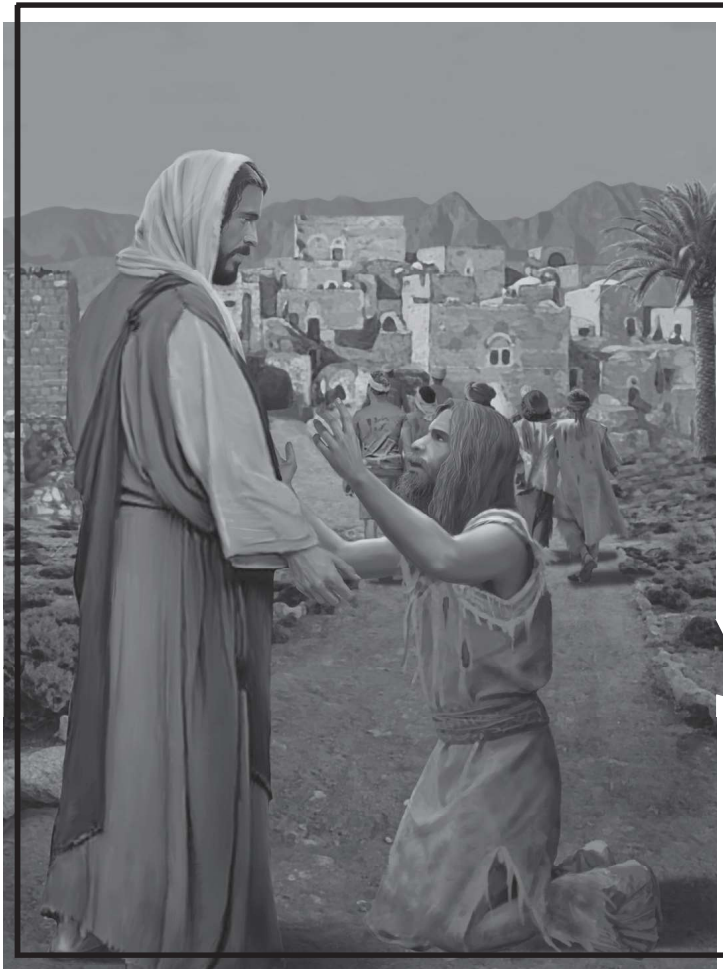
TRANSITION/GROUP TIME

BIBLE STORY STATEMENTS

- » Jesus walked down a road.
- » He saw ten sick men who called loudly to Him.
- » Jesus wanted to help the men.
- » He told the men to go see the priest (church helper). Jesus made the men well as they went.
- » One man returned and said, "Thank You, Jesus!"

BIBLE WORDS 6

- » Jesus, men, thank

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING

Jesus helped people because He loved them.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Luke 17:11-19

BIBLE VERSE

Jesus traveled to towns and healed the sick.
Matthew 9:35

LIFE POINT

Jesus healed people because He is God's Son.

REMEMBER TO

Use a calm, quiet voice.

Focus attention on the babies.

Review parents' instructions and any medical information.

Put take-home items in children's bags.

Make a final diaper check.

Release children to authorized adults.



BIBLE-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

ERASE DOTS FROM A PICTURE

Gather: Printables: “Body Outline”; gallon-size ziplock bag, dry erase markers, paper towels;

Optional: Pack Item 4: “Teaching Pictures 5 & 6”; scissors

Do: Place “Body Outline” inside of the gallon bag and zip closed. Draw dots on the bag within the outline of the person. **Optional:** Cut apart the teaching pictures.

- » Show a baby the person with the dots.
- » Say that in our Bible story 10 men were sick. We will pretend the person in the bag is sick.”
- » **Optional:** Show Teaching Picture 6.
- » Review the Bible story.
- » Use a paper towel to erase a dot. Let the child erase the other dots.
- » Say that the body is clean. State that Jesus healed the men so they were no longer sick.
- » Repeat the process by drawing the dots again. Ask another child to erase the dots.
- » State: “Jesus helped people because He loved them. Jesus was able to heal people because He is God’s Son.”

READ BOOKS

Gather: Bible, Bible storybooks, assorted books, large pillow or blanket; **Optional:** Pack Item 25: “Book: Jesus Helped”

Do: Place the books on the pillow or blanket.

- » Invite a baby to join you on the pillow or blanket. Look at the Bible or read a book.
- » **Optional:** Read aloud *Jesus Helped*. Talk about the things Jesus did to help people.
- » Place a book in front of a baby. Point to the pictures in the book. Express thanks for the things you see in the pictures.
- » Sit beside a baby with the Bible. Allow the baby to gently open the Bible. Show him a picture of Jesus in the Bible.
- » State: “Jesus helped people because He loved them.”

COUNT TO TEN

Gather: Music; gloves; **Optional:** Pack Item 4: “Teaching Pictures 5 & 6”; scissors

Do: Optional: Cut apart the teaching pictures.

- » Place the gloves on your hands.
- » **Optional:** Point to Teaching Picture 6. Talk about the ten men in the Bible story.
- » Count aloud to 10 using your fingers.
- » Sing “Let’s All Celebrate Jesus.”
- » Say: “Jesus made ten sick men well and only one said thank you.”
- » Allow the kids to put on the gloves and wiggle their fingers. Sing the song again.
- » Say that Jesus healed people because He is God’s Son.

PLAY WITH TOY PEOPLE FIGURES

Gather: Toy people figures, small box;

Optional: Pack Item 12: “Bible Words 5 & 6”

Do: Place the people figures in the box.

Optional: Separate Bible Words 6 and place in the box with the figures.

- » Guide a baby to take an item from the box.
- » Show a toy figure from the box. Say that our Bible story is about ten men.
- » **Optional:** Invite a baby to take a Bible Word from the box. Read aloud the word, corresponding to the Bible story.
- » Allow a baby to remove a toy figure from the box. Mention that only one man came back to thank Jesus for making him well.
- » **Optional:** Recall the Bible story as you say each Bible Word from the box.
- » State: “Jesus traveled to towns and healed the sick. Matthew 9:35.”
